General Information

1. Pre-entry fee \$20/class
2. Marshall & Sterling class \$35.00/class.
3. Pre-entries close the Friday before the show date.
4. Entry fee, day of show, will be \$25/class
5. Neither the horse show committee, PJHSA, Boots and Saddle Riding Club, Inc. or its Board of Directors, members or volunteers will be held responsible for damage, injury or loss to person, horse/ pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the show grounds.
6. Anyone or any horse suspended from the USEF will not be permitted to show at Boots and Saddle Riding Club.
7. Classes for junior riders are limited to riders who have not reached their 19th birthday prior to December 1, 2021.
8. Six ribbons are awarded in each class, champion and reserve awarded in all divisions with 3 or more entries.
9. All riders must wear an ASTM approved helmet when mounted.
10. The decision of the judge is final.
11. No martingales permitted in under saddle classes.
12. All fence heights are approximate.
13. All classes receive PJHSA points unless otherwise noted.
14. Complete specs for PJHSA can be found out www.pjhsa.org
15. There will be a \$50 fee for any non-negotiable checks.
16. It is expected that all returned checks will be “made good” within 5 days from notice.
17. Proof of negative coggins is required.
18. Social Distancing is required.
