Division Descriptions

Leadline: Available to anyone 3-7 years old with leader of 18 & up. No cross entering. Judged on hands, seat and control of mount.

Mini Stirrup: Riders 10 & under. Cannot cross enter into a canter class. CC eligibility is 8 & under.

Open W/T: Open to all riders and horses/ponies. PJHSA only – not CC.

Cross Rail Eq: Open to Jr/Amateur riders that have not shown over a 2' course or higher. 18" jumps on the rail twice around the outside. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Cross Rail Hunter: Open to Jr/Amateur riders that have not shown over a 2' course or higher. 18" Cross Rail courses. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Pleasure Horse or Pony: Open to all riders.

Novice Equitation: Open to Jr/Amateur riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in the previous year. 2' course. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Modified Hunter: Open to Jr/Amateur riders. 2' course. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

Baby Green: Open to all horses/ponies in their first two years of showing. Open to Amateurs as well as Professionals. Trotting in corners will not be penalized. Rider choice 2' or 2'3".

Low Hunter: Open to Jr/Amateur riders. 2'3" course

Jr/Adult Eq: Open to all non-professionals 2'3" or 2'6".

Schooling Hunter: Open to all riders, professionals or amateurs, adults or juniors. Shown over a course of eight (8) or more fences, 2'6" or 3' rider's choice.

Children's Pony/Horse/Adult Hunter: Open to Jr/Amateur riders. S/M 2', L 2'6", Horse 3' course.

M&S Classes – see rule book for specifics.

Hunter Derby: Hunt and Go Derby. Fences will be at 2' with 2'3 options or 2'6 with 2'9 options. Riders may choose which height they would like to do. The Round will be given 2 numeric scores. One score for their Classic section and one for their Handy section. These scores will be combined to determine the final placing. Ribbons: 1-10.

Rules and Guidelines

1. Entries will be accepted via email to turtlehillec@gmail.com or online at www.horseshowing.com.

2. Post entries: Entries close at noon the Friday before each show.

3. Fees: All entries must pay a \$20.00 fee. (\$15.00 grounds fee and \$5.00 EMT fee).

4. A processing fee of \$75.00 will be charged for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will result in rider being forbidden to show at any future Stonegate Stables shows.

5. Hard hats must be worn at all times while riding at Stonegate Stables, LLC. Hard hats with attached harnesses must be worn by all junior riders.

6. No junior rider may ride or handle stallions.

7. No dogs allowed on property.

8. Current negative coggins required.

9. The show management reserves the right to combine, change location or add a schooling if deemed necessary.

10. Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing. In the event of a division tie, the tie breaker will be determined by the over fence classes.

11. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.

12. The horse show committee, nor Stonegate Stables, LLC will not be responsible for any damages, injury, or loss of persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
